

KCIC CAMP RULES AND DISCIPLINE POLICY

1. In order to keep all children safe, we strongly discourage parent or guardian visits during camp. Security and safety is our first priority. Screening visitors coming onto the camp property takes away from our programs and activities. A number will be provided for parents to call in case of emergency.
2. **No pets** are allowed on Rotary Camp property. Please do not bring pets when dropping off or picking up campers. This does not include service animals.
3. **All** medication must be checked in with the Camp Director upon arrival and kept in the Health Lodge. This includes over the counter medication.
4. Campers are required to use the Buddy System at all times at camp.
5. Campers must treat other campers, camp staff, and guests with Respect. This includes giving full attention to counselors, speakers and activity leaders. Campers will not engage in physical violence, destructive behavior, name calling, verbal insults, hazing, bullying, theft, or possess/use drugs or alcohol.
6. Campers must treat Rotary camp property, plants and creatures with respect. Do not disturb the plants and wildlife. Stay on designated trails. Leave the campgrounds better than you found them. Keep litter picked up.
7. No food of any kind is to be kept in cabins by the campers.
8. No weapons of any kind are allowed. Please do not bring jewelry, tobacco products, magazines, radios/mp3 players/CDs, cameras, hand held video games, cell phones/pagers, or pocketknives. **KCIC is not responsible for loss or destruction of expensive and/or personal items.**
9. For safety reasons, campers **MUST** wear shoes/sandals (No Flip Flops) to the pool and at all times.
10. Campers must remain in their cabin after lights out unless they have permission from their counselor.
11. Rules and instruction for use of the swimming pool will be given by Rotary staff prior to first swim. No running or horseplay is allowed in the swim area or shower house. Swimmers must pass the swim test before being allowed in the deep end. No diving except from the diving blocks in the deep end.
12. **Campers must be picked up by 12:00 noon on June 19th. If campers are not picked up within one hour of pick up time and the Camp Director has not been contacted with arrangements for pick up, the proper authorities will be contacted.**

This list is not intended to be all inclusive. Campers are expected to follow any other rules and instructions set forth by the Rotary Camp staff and/or KCIC Camp staff.

Violation of camp rules may result in being sent home.
